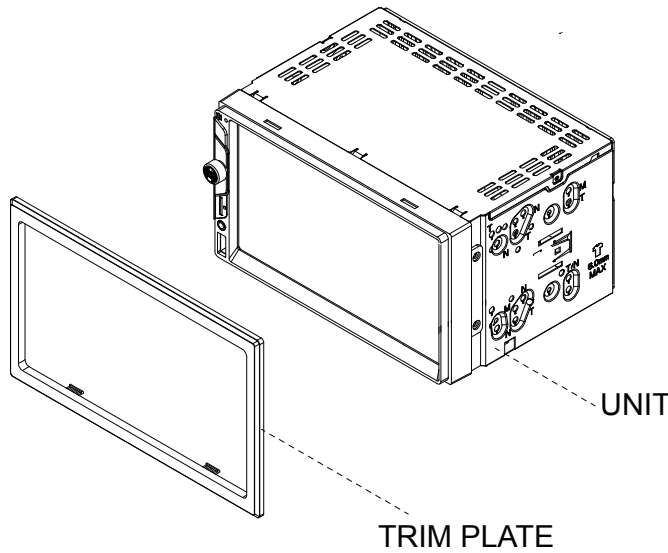

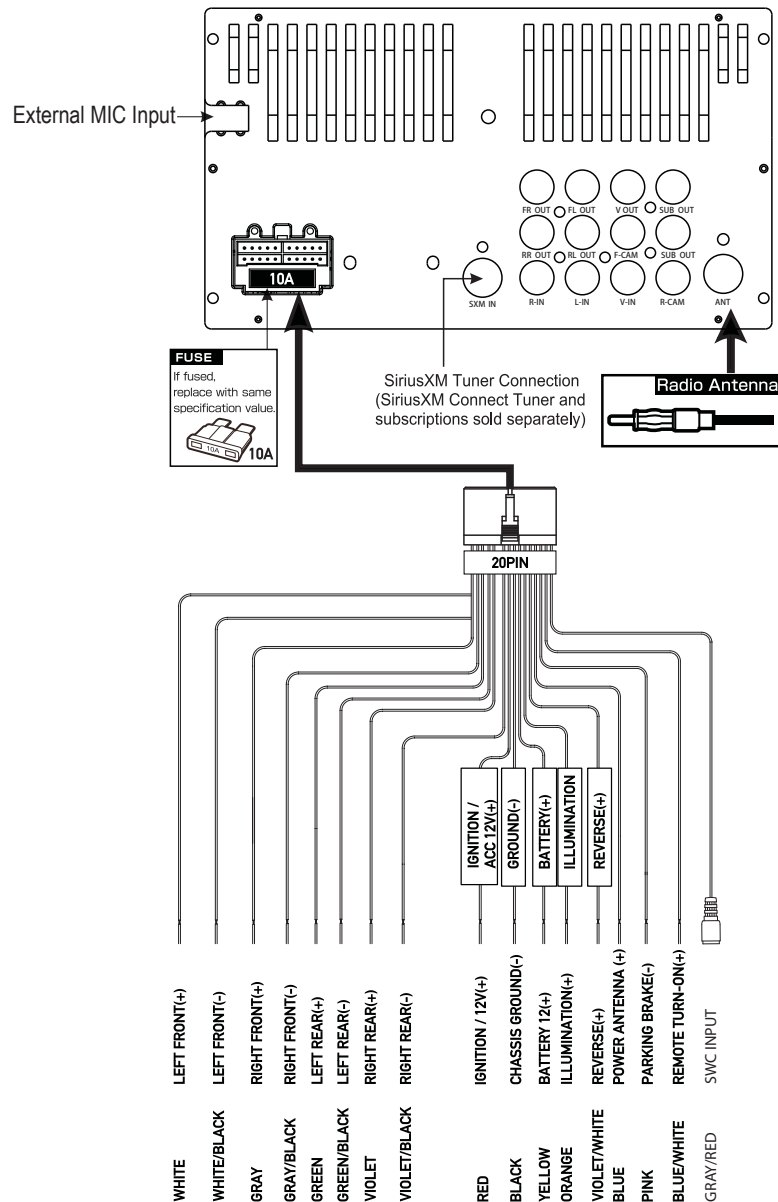


TYPICAL FRONT-LOAD DIN MOUNTING METHOD

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Wiring Diagram - Inputs/Outputs

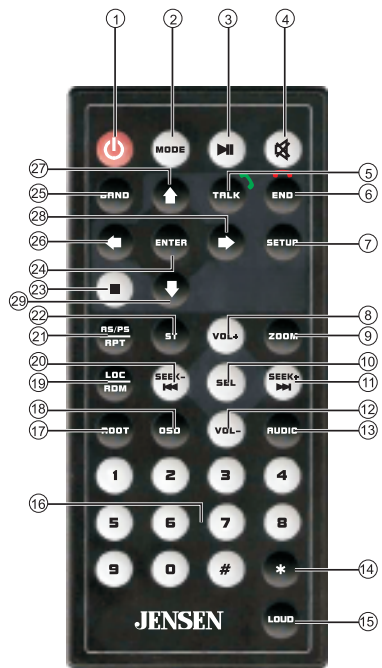

Main Menu

In the Menu mode, press the desired icon to enter the corresponding mode: Radio, SiriusXM®, BT Phone, USB, microSD Card, BT Audio, Aux In, AV In, Camera, and Settings.



General Operation

Press the function icons to select the setup menu.



Audio Operation

Press Sound Effect icon in the Settings menu to select EQ Presets, Surround Settings, Fader and Balance controls.

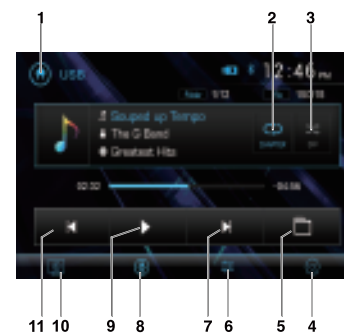

SiriusXM® Operation

- 1. Band**
Displays SiriusXM® radio band currently selected. Third bands are available: SXM1, SXM2, and SXM3.
- 2. Search**
Press this icon to search channels by category
- 3. Channel List**
Press this icon to see the preset channels per band.
- 4. Function**
Press this icon to list mode/Tune Scan/ Go to Live channels.
- 5. Channel Down**
Press this icon to select station backward manually
- 6. Channel Up**
Press this icon to select station forward manually
- 7. Skip Backward**
Tap this icon to skip to the beginning of the current song or prior songs. Press and hold to fast reverse.
- 8. Pause**
Press this icon to pause the audio.
- 9. Skip Forward**
Tap this icon to skip to the next song. Press and hold to fast forward.
- 10. Preset**
Press and hold to add the current channel to a preset. Tap to recall the preset. a total of 18 presets can be stored, 6 per band.
- 11. Content Info**
Press Song icon to cycle through song, content info and description field



Bluetooth Operation

Bluetooth Microphone

The built-in microphone is on the front of the receiver. External microphone is included, designed to mount on the visor or on a pillar inside the vehicle.

Preparation

Before you can use a Bluetooth device, it must be paired and connected. Make sure that Bluetooth is activated on your device before you begin the pairing process.

Pairing a New Device

The unit broadcasts the pairing signal constantly when no devices are currently connected. Complete the pairing sequence from your Bluetooth device. Refer to the owner's manual for your device for more details. The device name is "JENSEN CR271ML". The unit can be in any mode of operation when pairing is performed.

Connecting a Paired Device

Most Bluetooth devices support the auto-connect feature and will connect automatically if the device is in range when the unit is powered-on. If your device was previously paired but does not connect, enter the Bluetooth setup menu and ensure that Auto Connect is On.

Dialing a Number

Press to display keypad and dial a number.

Making and Ending a Call

Press to connect a call, and press to end a call.

Transferring Audio

Press to transfer audio between the head unit and mobile phone.

Streaming Audio

Press to play or pause the music. Press to skip to the previous track. Press to advance to the next track.

Phone Book

Press to download the phone numbers or access the call history info.



Voice Activation Operation

Bluetooth should be paired between your smartphone and the receiver. Press the voice activation button , and the receiver will switch into Bluetooth mode. This will activate Siri® or Google Assistant™ on your smartphone. You will need to manually switch back to the previous or desired mode once this operation is terminated.

APP Operation

The Jensen Smart App is the ultimate wireless remote control for your CR271ML receiver. You can download the Jensen Smart app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store and install it on your smartphone or tablet.
