



# Wiring Diagram - Input / Outputs







- Try to perform pairing within a few minutes of the mobile phone being turned on. • Once the unit has been paired with the mobile phone, the unit's model number, "JENSEN BT", will be displayed on the mobile phone
- To achieve the best performance, always keep the mobile phone within 10 feet (3 meters)
