

# Installation




Using the existing brackets or the brackets supplied with the installation kit, mount the brackets to the sides of the head unit with the screws supplied with the head unit.





# **Bluetooth Operation**

### **Bluetooth Microphone**

The external microphone should be mounted in a high clear area, pointed directly at the driver seat.

### **Pairing and Connecting**

Before using Bluetooth functions, you must pair your mobile phone to the VX3228 unit. The device name is "Jensen". The Bluetooth passcode

"5309". To ensure the best reception for pairing and re-connection, please make sure the mobile phone battery is fully charged before you begin.

# Dialing a Number

Press to display keypad and dial a number.

# Making and Ending a Call

Press \( \) to connect a call, and press \( \bullet \) to end a call

### **Transferring Audio**

Press to transfer audio between the head unit and mobile phone.

# **Streaming Audio**

Press I to play or pause the music.

Press to advance to the next track.
